

First Time Visitor FAQ

What can I expect on my first visit?

We worship in an historic, renovated 1930 sanctuary with stained-glass images from Scripture and the Christian tradition. Our congregational singing is accompanied by an organ or piano (9AM) or band (10:30 AM). Services always include prayer, sometimes directly from Scripture or a church father or mother, and sometimes extemporaneous. Sermons are about 25 minutes long and focus on teaching God's truth to us from the Old and New Testaments.

I have kids! Where do they go?

Children's ministry is offered during the 10:30 service in the Lower Level. For your convenience, you can pre-register your children here. We offer nursery (birth-age 2), Little Lambs (age 3-Kindergarten), and Sunday Kids' Camp (grades 1-2 and 3-4). On the first Sunday of each month, Sunday Kids' Camp children are invited to join sanctuary worship with their parents as we participate in the sacrament of communion. Children are always invited to sit with their parents in each service, if they prefer. We offer quiet activity options.

Where can I park?

Parking is available in our attached lot, both on the side and around the back of the building. Parking is also available on the surrounding streets, including 4th Street and Lincoln Ave.
